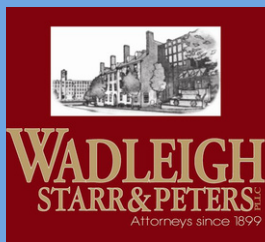

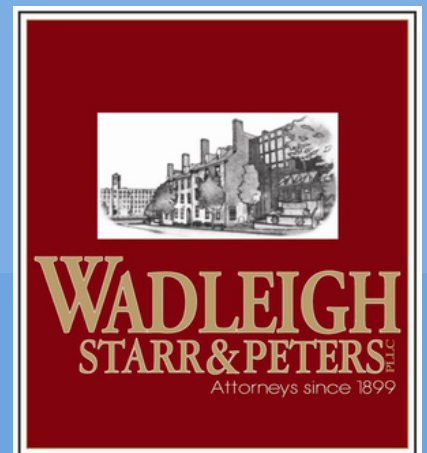
## **What's New? The Year in Review**
